

How to Convert Video in to DV Stream (NTSC) Using MPEG Streamclip:

1. Open video in MPEG Streamclip
 2. Select "File" – "Export to Quicktime"
 3. The MPEG Streamclip – Movie Exporter window will open. From here select the following parameters:
 - a. Compression: Apple DV/DVCPRO – NTSC
 - b. Quality: 100%
 - c. Frame Size: Unscaled
 - d. Deselect "Interlaced Scaling"
 - e. Select "Options" – make sure to select the correct aspect ratio that corresponds with the original picture.
 - i. If standard definition select:
 1. Scan Mode: Interlaced
 2. Aspect Ratio: 4:3
 - ii. If progressive select:
 1. Scan Mode: Progressive
 2. Aspect Ratio: 16:9
 4. When done, select "Make Movie"
- To convert multiple videos at once, select "List" from the main toolbar and then select "Batch Convert" – The above steps still apply.
 - Be sure to preview your video in Finder to insure that it plays back correctly
